

### TOWN OF WEBB UFSD AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN 2020-2024

The 2021-22 enacted state budget included language requiring each LEA receiving federal ARP-ESSER funding to post the following on their website on or before July 1, 2021, a plan by school year of how such funds will be expended and how the LEA will prioritize spending on non-recurring expenses to meet students' social, emotional, mental health and academic needs.

After soliciting input from the school community including, teachers & staff (35.7%), parents (57.1%) and community members (7.1%) the district has identified the following areas to be addressed:

- Academic Supports & Interventions
- Social-Emotional Supports
- Athletics
- Educational Technology
- After School Programing
- Summer learning/enrichment

The District has read through the comments and suggestions and recognizes that the health & wellness of its entire school community (students, staff & parents) is essential to the success of the district. The allocation of funds is \$180,774 with a minimum allocation of 12.5% per year (\$22,596) for four years with the remaining allocation of \$90,378 to be expensed as needed. The following represents the District's plan to expense the funds.

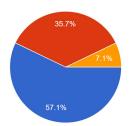
# **Other Expenditures**

What category do you best represent with your submission today? 56 responses

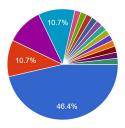

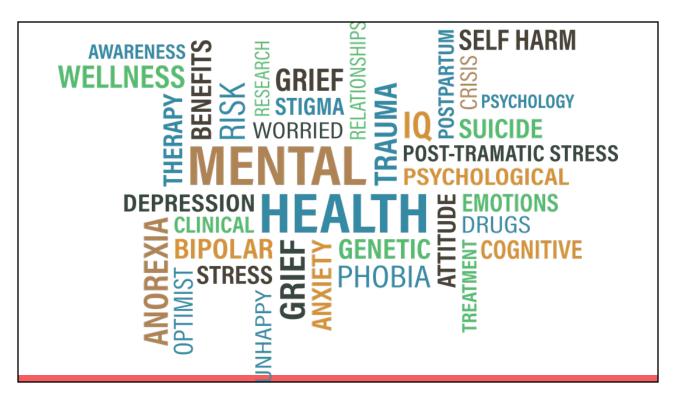
