

TRANSPORTATION ROUTING

Bus routes are established under the direction of the Transportation Supervisor and/or contractor.

1. Limitations - Bus routes will be established so as to provide the students with as reasonable a length of time riding the bus as possible.

Students who attend educational programs at sites other than Town of Webb Union Free School buildings may require a longer transportation time.

Authorized bus stops will be located at convenient intervals in places where students may be loaded and unloaded, may cross highways, and may wait the arrival of buses with the utmost safety allowed by road conditions.

2. Side Roads/ Private Roads - Transportation will not be provided on roadways that are not maintained by town, county, and/or state highway departments if the lack of maintenance makes it unsafe for drivers and students to be traversing these roads. Examples of unsafe conditions are flooding, road erosion, ice and snow or mud.
3. Turn Arounds - Turn arounds will not be established unless adequate space is available and this space is properly maintained by town, county, and/or state highway departments.
4. District Map - Maps may be used in determining the transportation requirements necessary to satisfy the needs established by state law, Board Policy, and voter mandate.
